HOW TO USE 'DISCOVER JESUS' WITH THOSE
INTERESTED IN KNOWING MORE ABOUT JESUS

People's stories matter.

They reveal who we are, what is important to us, what gives us life, joy, purpose and what causes us pain, despair, and discontent. As we make time to hear people's stories and get to know them, we allow space and time to share our story with them.

For followers of Jesus, our story has been forever changed by Him, what is important to us, our values and motivations.

As we share our life and faith, some people will ask questions and express an interest that leads to conversations about God/Jesus. If they appear open and interested, you can ask:

"Would you be interested in reading some of the Bible with me and discover more about Jesus?"



STARTING DISCOVER JESUS WITH SOMEONE:

01 Plan a time and place to meet regularly, preferably somewhere comfortable with few distractions.

02 Ask if there is anyone else they know who may be interested in joining you. If it is appropriate and helpful, you could invite friends from your Disciple Community to join you.

03 Ask if they would prefer to download the You Bible App, or use a hard copy of the Bible. If they would like to use the app, take them through the download and how it works. If they prefer a hard copy of the Bible, offer to purchase one for them or let them know where they can purchase one for themselves.

04 Suggest a version of the Bible that is appropriate for them. ESV, NIV, NLT or “Easy.” Easy English by Wycliffe is helpful for those with English as a second language or who find reading difficult.

05 As they read by themselves, encourage them to write down, text, or call you with any questions, things they want to discuss, or are finding difficult to understand.

06 If they show interest in reading the Bible between your meetings, suggest the Reading Plans in this booklet on page 14.

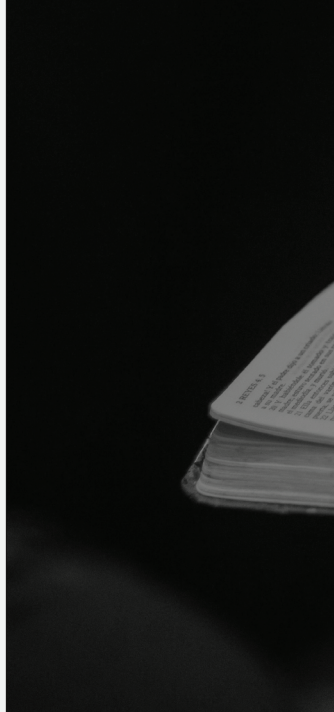

GOOD OR GOD



Invite them to share:

- GOOD: stories in their life of good things that they can thank God for.
- GOD: stories in their life of where they have seen God at work.


Questions you could ask:

- Were you able to apply anything from what we have been reading?
- Did you have the opportunity to share what you learnt last week with someone?

We follow a simple 4 step pattern when we meet with people to read about Jesus in the Bible. The pattern is designed to help you build a relationship with them as they begin to discover Jesus for themselves. We use this same pattern in the way we do Disciple Groups.

03

PRAYER & CARE

By praying for them and inviting them to pray for you, you are reinforcing that they can speak to God and that God hears them as well.

Ask:

- Is there something I can pray for you?
- Is there any area in your life that you would need a breakthrough in?
- Would you be comfortable praying for me about?

04

LIVING IT OUT

Encourage them to:

- Put what they have learned into practise.
- Share what they have learned with someone before we meet again.
- Read more of the Bible between now and when we meet again.
- Contact you if they have any questions.

Discover Bible

HEAD, HEART AND HANDS



The Discover Method is designed to engage everyone in the learning, discovery and application of the Bible.

WHY DISCOVER BIBLE?

- God wants to speak to and through each person as they read the Bible together.
- The Holy Spirit is our teacher who inspires and reveals truth.
- It is a simple pattern that can be used by young and old, those

with little or much faith or biblical knowledge.

- It provides a simple and easy way for groups and those exploring faith to explore the fundamental truths found within a Bible passage and begin to apply what they learn.

The Bible is the primary resource. Discover Bible does not require prior biblical knowledge, a gifted teacher, sermons, DVDs, podcasts or study resources.

Discover Bible

PRAYER

- Pray - Ask the Holy Spirit to teach and lead us into truth.

READ

- Ask everyone to read the passage out loud or multiple people if it's a long passage.
 - Ask everyone to read the passage to themselves (invite them to read the passage using a second translation) or if its a story, have someone retell it in their own words.
- N.B. You can also play an audio version if that is helpful.

THREE SIMPLE QUESTIONS

HEAD

- What do we learn about God and people?

HEART

- What parts of the passage spoke to your heart?

HANDS

- How can you put what you have learnt into practice this week?



WEEKLY PLANS & SUGGESTED READINGS

The plans are divided into seven readings with a suggested reading to do together in bold e.g. **1:1-12**.

Some readings have more than one story, teaching or big idea. You can read the whole reading and work through it, or you can chose to zero in on one key story, teaching or idea within the reading and focus on it. This is a “less is more” or “quality over quantity” approach.
